1 STATION 1 Sahat Al Nakheel

Sahat Al Nakheel is Msheireb Downtown Doha's main commercial hub. It is an open square linked to Qatar's largest metro station "Msheireb Station".

Enjoy the celebrations with Al Sikah Festival hosting various experiences, cuisines and activations.

2 STATION 2 Wadi Msheireb

Sikkat Wadi Msheireb the longest pedestrian street in Msheireb. The word "Wadi" means "valley" in Arabic which portrays how this area used to be a source of fresh water for the community.

The Sikka offers picturesque street-side shops and restaurants. Its beautiful, linear water features celebrate the wadi and its water. It is also home to Park Hyatt Doha 5-star Hotel and Doha Design District.

3 STATION 3 Galleria

To the left, you will find Msheireb Galleria which has a variety of shops, cafes, Monoprix and Novo Cinemas. And to the right is the Host Country Media Center.

In addition, there are various cultural and sports exhibitions within Sahat Wadi Msheireb which is located adjacent to Al Wadi Doha MGALLERY 5-Star Hotel.

This beautiful area is connected to Souq Waqif, a traditional touristic destination in Qatar.

5 STATION 5 Heritage Quarter

The heritage Quarter is home to Msheireb Museums and Msheireb Prayer ground. The historical Msheireb Prayer Ground is a key restoration project in Msheireb Downtown Doha and a significant cultural and religious place in Doha.

Msheireb Museums tell the story of four remarkable historic houses in the heart of the city and takes you through a journey to explore some of the most enticing untold stories from Qatar's socio-economic history.

It currently celebrates the National Football team achievements through Al Annabi Village.

6 STATION 6 Al Baraha

Barahat Msheireb is an open space for socialization. It is the region's largest open square with a retractable roof and sustainable cooling systems.

You can enjoy the Baraha activations by watching live games and choosing from the delicious gastronomy options.

It is the centre point for retail, fine dining restaurants and coffee shops. It is anchored by the luxurious Mandarin Oriental Doha 5-star hotel to the left and to the right is M7; Qatar's epicenter for innovation and entrepreneurship in fashion, design, and technology.

7 STATION 7 Sahat Al Masjid

An area where you can experience its unique architecture and pattern designs inspired by Qatari heritage, nature and its famous small alleys known as "Sikka" that naturally provide shade from the intense sun. Barahat Msheireb mosque is also near by and next to it is a small garden which holds our city's remarkable sundial.

8 STATION 8 Al Kahraba Street

Al Kahraba Street (Arabic for electricity) is the cultural soul and link of the city district to its past.

The street is one of the oldest and the first to get electricity in Qatar, making it a true reflection of the rising commercial importance of the Msheireb area. The neighborhood now holds green gardens, stores, cafes, restaurants and is few steps away from Qatar Academy - Msheireb.
